## STUDENT COVID-19 QUICK FACTS

### STUDENT RESPONSIBILITIES

- Facial coverings are <u>mandatory</u> in all indoor spaces and outdoors where 6 feet of social distancing is not possible, including walking to and from classes
- Upload vaccination status (one-time) in the College of the Redwoods Campus App; OR
- If un-vaccinated, complete **daily pre-screenings** in the **Campus App** or with a **health screener** on campus
- After completing the health screening, receive a pass through the Campus App <u>OR</u> a wristband from a health screener
- **Use QR codes** and the **Campus App** to scan into classrooms and other areas for contact tracing purposes







## If you have a confirmed case of COVID-19:

- ▶ Contact College of the Redwoods Public Safety Manager **Kristy Seher** at 707-476-4550 or <u>kristy-seher@redwoods.edu</u> immediately.
- ▶ Record your COVID status in the "**Report Test Results**" section of the Campus App.
- ▶ Investigation of exposed classroom begins. Students are notified through the Campus App or Student Email, verification of attendance/enrollment is done.

### **Return-to-Campus Criteria:**

**COVID-19 positive cases with COVID-19 symptoms** (Vaccinated or Un-Vaccinated) will not return to any college facility until all of the following have occurred:

- At least 24 hours have passed since a fever of 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit or higher has resolved without the use of fever-reducing medications; and
- COVID-19 symptoms have improved; and
- At least 10 days have passed since COVID-19 symptoms first appeared.
- A clearance from the County Health Department, a medical professional, or a negative test will be required\*.

**COVID-19 positive cases without COVID-19 symptoms** (Vaccinated or Un-Vaccinated) will not return to any college facility until:

- A minimum of 10 days have passed since the date of specimen collection of their first positive COVID-19 test.
- A clearance from the County Health Department, a medical professional, or a negative test will be required.

## If you have been exposed to a known COVID case

(within 6 feet for greater than 15 minutes in a 24 hour period):

- ▶ Record your COVID status in the "Daily Pre-Screening" section of the Campus App.

### **Return-to-Campus Criteria:**

**Vaccinated** persons who had a close contact but never developed any COVID-19 symptoms may remain on campus and should continue to monitor symptoms.

**Un-Vaccinated and Vaccinated** persons who had a close contact and developed any COVID-19 symptoms cannot return until:

- At least 24 hours have passed since a fever of 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit or higher has resolved without the use of fever-reducing medications; and
- COVID-19 symptoms have improved; and
- At least 10 days have passed since COVID-19 symptoms first appeared.
- A clearance from the County Health Department, a medical professional, or a negative test will be required\*.

\*PCR test is preferred, but antigen tests are acceptable. Record your COVID status in the "**Report Test Results"** section of the Campus App.
